General Information

Terrace Manor Elementary School offers and incorporates many special programs including our Before School Tiger Reading and Writing Lab, 4th and 5th Grade Chorus, Student Council, Spelling Bee Club, and Helen Ruffin Reading Bowl Club. We also continually spotlight our students with Perfect Attendance goals. Terrace Manor Elementary School is also incorporating a College and Career Readiness theme. College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
