Simile

Comparison of two things using *like* or *as*

My dog is like a tornado.



FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE

Words used to say something beyond their actual meaning

Figurative language is used to describe, explain, or emphasize something in an imaginative, memorable way.

When you use words to say exactly what you mean, you're being literal.

Metaphor

Comparison of two things that does NOT use like or as

l'm so tired, l'm basically a zombie!
