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Richmond County Schools benefit from MIND Research Institute grant

(AUGUSTA, GEORGIA) – Ten Richmond County Schools will receive additional math resources and specialized teacher training courtesy of a generous grant from MIND Research Institute.

The three-year grant provides students with ST Math, an online program that provides visual supplemental math instruction through challenging puzzles, non-routine problem solving and informative feedback. ST Math is based on the brain's ability to reason rather than focusing on memorization. Teachers will receive customized training and professional development to implement the program for their students.

"Our goal is to provide teachers with tools to support the academic achievement and success of our students," said Dr. Malinda Cobb, Associate Superintendent of Academic Services. "These resources enhance our math curriculum with added reasoning skills and critical thinking challenges that help prepare them for life beyond the classroom."
