VISION STATEMENT


The Richmond County School System will provide an equitable education for all students to prepare them for life beyond the classroom.

Title IX



What is it?

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (Title IX) is a federal law that prohibits discrimination based on sex in education programs and activities that receive federal financial assistance. Title IX states “No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.” It includes sexual harassment.



Title IX



What must be done?

1. Conduct and document annual training of all school personnel to inform them of their reporting responsibilities.
2. Post and include in publications notices explaining Title IX rights that are visible for students, parents and employees.
3. Follow Title IX reporting processes for any instances of discrimination or harassment based on sex.
