School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This plan describes how Richmond Hill K-8 School will provide opportunities to improve parent engagement and support student learning. Richmond Hill K-8 believes that parent involvement means the participation of parents in regular two-way and meaningful communication about student academic learning and other school activities. We value the contributions and involvement of parents in establishing an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that Richmond Hill K-8 will support parent engagement and how parents can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and home.

How it was created and how it is revised?

EOY Title I meeting was held at Richmond K-8 virtually. Parents were invited to share their ideas and opinions in revising/creating a new school policy and compacts, that would serve as the foundation for parental engagement at Richmond Hill K-8 School.

Revisions will occur throughout the year. Parents will be invited to the Annual BOY and EOY Title I Meetings, as well as, Input/Revision meetings. Input/Feedback are welcomed anytime. Feedback/Comments sheets will be located in the Parent Resource Center.



Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A Program, and their families, are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Richmond Hill K-8 will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available?

The plan is available on the school website and in the office. Parents can also obtain a copy from the Parent Resource Center.

2023-2024 District Goals

- 1. During the 2023-2024 school year, we will increase student content mastery in tested subject areas on the Georgia Milestones by 3%.
- 2. During the 2023-2024 school year, we will increase post-high school readiness by increasing our graduation rate from 71%-75%.
- 3. During the 2023-2024 school year, we will increase the number of highly effective teachers and leaders retained in RCSS by 3%.

2023-24 School Goals

Initiative 1: By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, students performing on or above grade level in reading will increase by 25% from 24% (265 students) to 49% (541 students) as measured by iReady Reading.

Initiative 2: By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, students performing on or above grade level in math will increase by 20% from 24% (211 students) to 44% (488 students) as measured by iReady Math.

Initiative 3: By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, we will increase teacher retention by 25% from 63% (39 teachers) to 88% (55 teachers) as measured by the number of teacher retirements, resignations, and school transfers (to exclude new South ES).

- Send home daily or weekly homework assignments.
- Develop reading and math goals based on student data and assist students in reaching them.
- Provide monthly trainings for staff during their planning periods on strategies to improve communication with parents and ideas to increase family engagement.
- Staff will also share best practices during regularly scheduled faculty meetings.
- Communicate with all families and the community on a regular basis regarding school-wide events and activities, through phone messages, social media, and flyers.
- Work with our parents to develop relevant trainings and helpful presentations to educate our staff on the importance of parental involvement.
- Provide necessary materials and handouts for parents at conferences, meetings, and activities to help parents work with their child to improve their child's achievement.
- Use our Partners in Education and School-Community Team to improve awareness of the activities and events listed in the school parental involvement policy.
- Collect feedback from parents at all events, place input card around the building and post suggestion form on the school website in order to respond to parents' requests for additional support for parental involvement activities.
