Davidson student chosen to serve on 2023-24 State Superintendent Student Advisory Council

(AUGUSTA, GEORGIA) – John S. Davidson Fine Arts Magnet School junior Denzel Howard has been selected to serve on State Superintendent Richard Woods' 2023-24 Student Advisory Council.

“As a student advisory council member, Denzel is one of four representatives from the CSRA who will share his voice on educational policies that directly affect him and his peers,” said Dr. Kenneth Bradshaw, Superintendent of Schools. “We are proud to have Denzel be an ambassador for our school system as he participates in discussions and service projects.”

Howard joins 69 students from across Georgia who will meet with Superintendent Woods four times throughout the school year to provide feedback on the impact of state policies in the classroom. During his time on the council, Howard plans to develop a community service project for the Augusta community and wants to focus on issues affecting his peers.

“One issue that I would like to tackle is mental health-based,” said Howard, “I think once we get to the bottom of why so many students are feeling depressed and anxious, we are able to solve a problem that will better so many lives in the state.”
