Eight RCSS schools named Georgia Math Leaders

(AUGUSTA, GEORGIA) – Eight schools in the Richmond County School System (RCSS) were recognized as “Math Leaders” for exceptional achievement or growth in mathematics by the Georgia Department of Education. Schools were awarded based on the number of students achieving the Proficient Learner level or above on the Georgia Milestones mathematics assessments.

After the state of Georgia implemented new K-12 math standards last year, our math teachers worked hard to adjust their teaching styles accordingly.
