
2019-20 District Goals

2019-20 School Goals

Goal 1: Increase the number of students in third, fourth, and fifth grades who are proficient or above in reading by 3 percentile points as measured by the Georgia Milestones EOG assessment.

Goal 2: Increase the number of students in third, fourth, and fifth grades who are proficient or above in math by 3 percentile points as measured by the Georgia Milestones EOG assessment.
