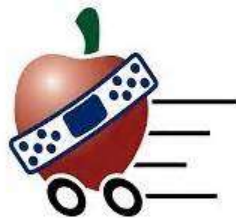

What is the Diploma Programme?

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (DP) is a two-year course of study that is globally recognized for its rigor and depth. It not only helps students develop a strong academic base for college, it empowers students to become well-rounded, reflective, life-long learners. Students will take 6 subjects along with the DP Core: Extended Essay; Creativity, Activity, & Service, and Theory of Knowledge.

What is the Career Related Programme?

The International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (IBCP) is an exciting, new addition to the programs of study offered at ARC! The IBCP couples recognized IB academic rigor with career preparation, service learning, and reflective, personal growth. It is a two-year course of study in which students engage in an accredited pathway of career study, take at least two IB courses, and immerse themselves in
