RCSS Spelling Bee in January...the date to be announced.

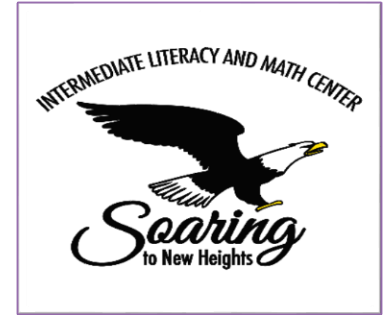
