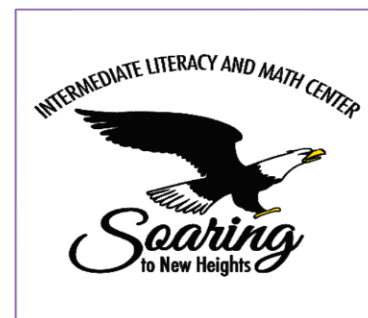
## School Information

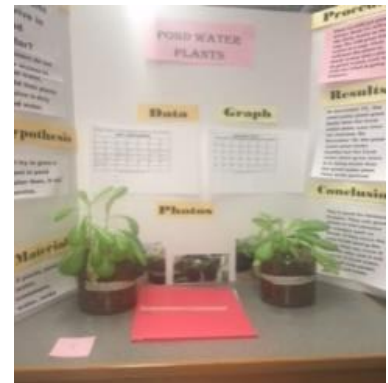
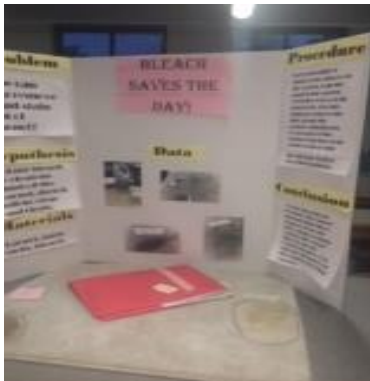
